



Authors' Information & Online Abstract Submission Guidelines

The Scientific Committee invites authors to submit abstracts to be considered for inclusion in the Scientific Program as Oral or Poster Presentations.

Participants wishing to contribute to the Scientific Program of the Congress are kindly requested to **submit their abstracts up to November 7th, 2010.**

The Scientific Committee will endeavour to schedule abstracts according to authors' Preferences but reserves the right to decide on the final form of presentation.

How to submit

Papers should be submitted only on line at www.greensys2011.com the abstract submission will start on May 2010.

The on-line system will take you step by step through the submission of your abstract.

Abstract format

1. File format:

Microsoft Word, file extension saved in doc. or .docx

Please name the file with the last name of the presenting author (i.e. Kamenova.doc). In case you have multiple submissions please number them (i.e. Kamenova2.doc)

2. Style:

- ◆ Page format: A4
- ◆ Maximum length: 1 page, maximum 300 words.
- ◆ Font style: Arial 10. Lines single spacing and fully "justified".
- ◆ Title: Arial Bold in capitals, 12 point type, left justification, must not exceed 20 words.

3. Please enter author & affiliation information as follows:

- ◆ The by-line under the title includes the name of author(s), the name of the Presenting Author should be mentioned first and be **in bold letters**.
- ◆ Please use 10 point type, left justification. The given name of authors must be written by initials. Initials are followed by a period. If two initials are listed, do not include a space between them but provide a space before the family name. The family name is always presented after the given name. If there is more than one author, separate the author's names by using commas (e.g. A.B. Smith, C.D. Jones, E.F. Brown).
- ◆ The affiliation of authors is included below the names. Please use 10 point type, left justification. Mention the department first, then the institution followed by city and country. Please separate with commas, abbreviate if necessary and please not that full postal addresses are unnecessary (e.g. Dpt. of Biological and Environmental Engineering, Cornell University, Ithaca NY, USA).
- ◆ If authors have different affiliations please index them according to this example (e.g. A.B. Smith¹, C.D. Jones², E.F. Brown¹). Use only numerical indexes after the surname of each author and before each affiliation (e.g. ¹Dpt. of Biological and Environmental Engineering, Cornell University, Ithaca NY, USA)

4. Body of text:

- ◆ Font style: Arial 10. Lines single spacing and fully "justified".
- ◆ Text must be continuous please do not divide in paragraphs.
